



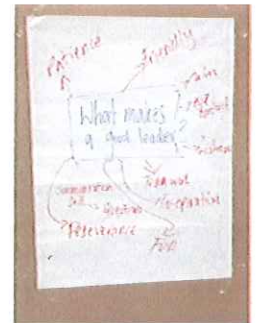
# Sports Weekly

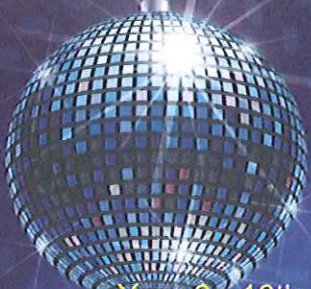
