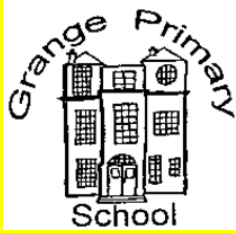

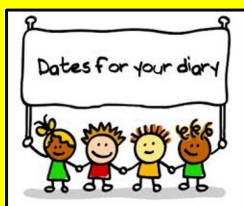

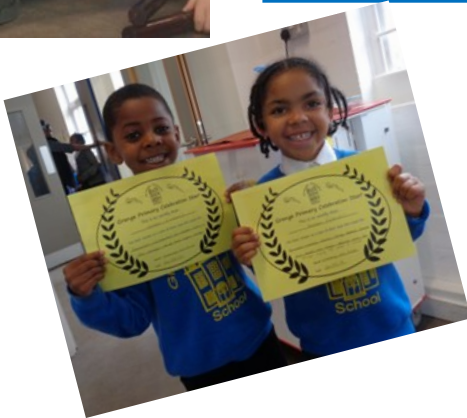


Venus

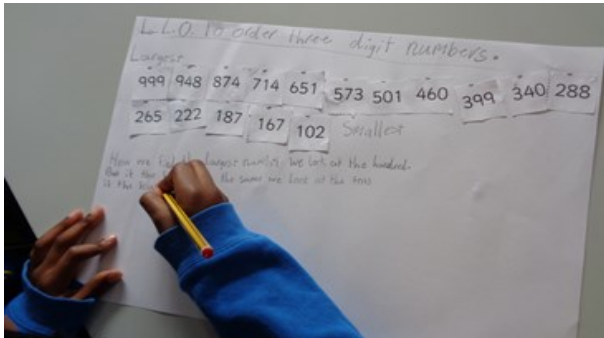
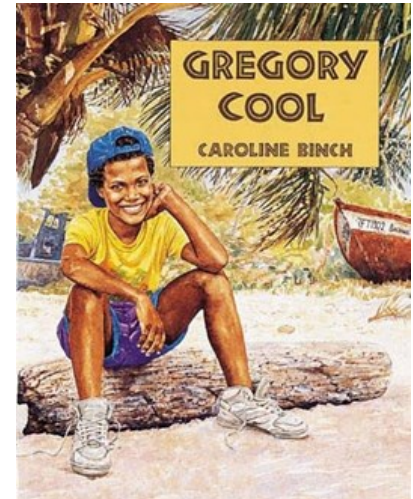
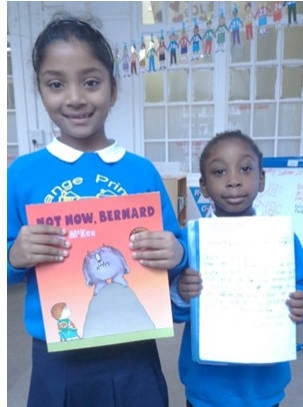
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Mars

Supernova started their swimming lessons last week. We are all very excited and the children have been very keen to develop their swimming skills!



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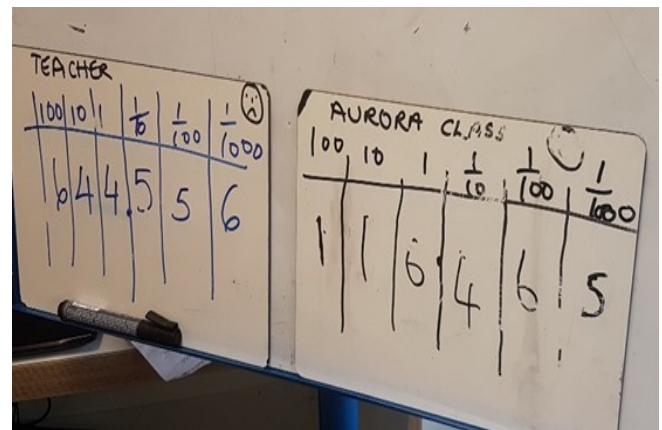


Pluto & Neptune
