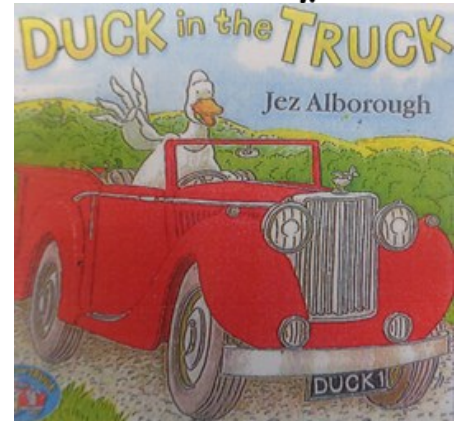
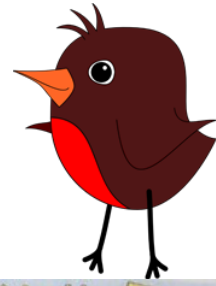

This term children in Supernova Class have been learning how to work with a partner during PE to improve their balance from a static position. Here is an example of the excellent work they have been doing.



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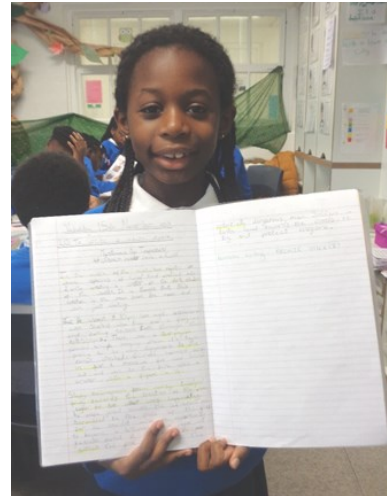
