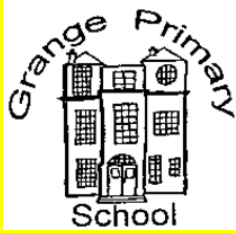

Supernova Class have been enjoying their ICT sessions, where they are getting used to using Purple Mash, which they can also do at home and various other computer programs.



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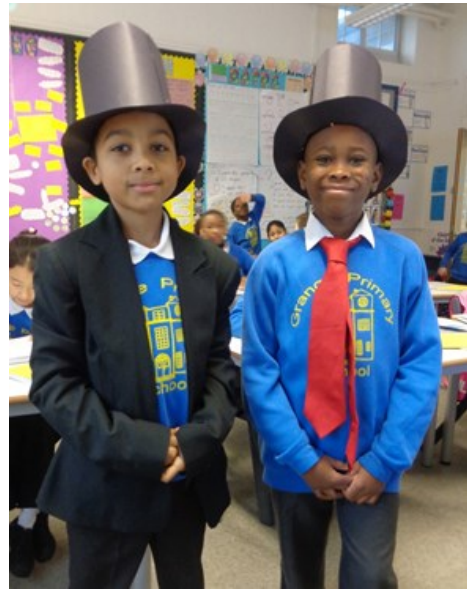
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Neptune
