Average Points of Progress for Pupil Premium Children

Year 1- 59 pps; EAL 33pps

Average Points of Progress

Year 1	Reading	Writing	Mathematics
All children	6.4	6.2	6.9
PP children	6.7	6.3	6.7

Pupil Premium children made good progress in Year 1. Compared to all children they made slightly better progress in in reading and writing and marginally lesser in mathematics. The gap between pupil premium and all children has been narrowed in Year 1.

Year 2- 60 pps; EAL 42 pps

Pupil Premium Children made the expected progress in Year 2. There is a very narrow gap between all children and Pupil Premium children in mathematics.

Year 3- 46pps; EAL 23pps

PP children	4.0	3.5	3.5

Pupil Premium children made good progress in reading, and better than expected in writing and mathematics. The gap between all children and pupil premium children is wider in mathematics, 0.4.

Year 4 - 44pps

PP children	3.6	3.5	4.0

Pupil premium children made good progress in mathematics and better than expected in reading and mathematics. The gap has been nearly closed between the progress all children and pupil premium children in the three core curriculum areas.

Year 5- 44pps

Pupil Premium children made good progress in all three areas and are on par with all children in Year 5.

Year 6-41pps

Pupil Premium children made excellent progress in all three core areas of the curriculum. Although there appear to be a larger gap between the progress achieved by all pupils and Pupil Premium children, the average point score show that the Pupil Premium progress has been more evenly spread across the KS2 for reading.

All Pupil Premium children are attaining better than the expected APS for Year 2.

Our Pupil Premium children are attaining better compared to all children.

Year 4 - 44pps

Pupil Premium children attained well at the end of Year 4 and are in line with their fellow peers.

Pupil Premium children attained in line with the APS expected for end of Year 4. On the overall they attained better than all children in their year group.
