KS2 data shows a very positive picture for PP learners. In RWM the PP group achieved 60% at the expected level which is in line with the national average for all pupils at 61% and 5% higher than 'All'.

The Disadvantaged learners achieved higher % at Expected in Reading and Maths compared to 'Non PP' and 'All'.

The Disadvantaged learners achieved higher % at Greater Depth in Reading compared to Non PP learners and 'All'.

The Disadvantaged pupils achieved in line with 'All' at Greater Depth in Writing and Maths.

The Disadvantaged learners have made better progress in all three core areas.

An area for focus in 17/18 for all pupils as well as PP Learners is improving RWM outcomes.

KS2 data shows an overall positive picture for PP learners. In RWM the PP group achieved 65% at the expected level which higher than the average for all pupils at 61% and 7% higher than 'Non PP'.

The Disadvantaged learners achieved higher % at Expected in Reading and Maths compared to 'Non PP' and 'All' is in line with 'Non PP' and 'All' in Writing.

The Disadvantaged learners achieved higher % at Greater Depth in Writing and combined RWM compared to 'Non PP' learners and 'All'.

The Disadvantaged pupils are in line with 'All' at Greater Depth in Maths.

An area for focus in 17/18 for all pupils as well as PP Learners is improving Reading outcomes.

Phonics

80% of all pupils passed the Phonics Screening test with 84% 'Non PP' and 75% PP.

The percentage of pupils achieving expected in Phonics has improved and in 2016-17 the school's outcomes for 'All' aligned with the national averages. This is an area the school needs to continue to improve.

EYFS

63% of all pupils achieved Good Level of Development.
