

Completing the Health Check takes about 5 minutes. It will ask you about your child's condition and their general wellbeing.

Afterwards, you will receive a summary of your child's results and a Health Support Pack. Your child's summary will also be added to their health record, to support your child's health team to better understand your child.




### Moon




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**Planet Earth**




