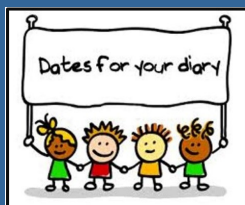

#### Weather

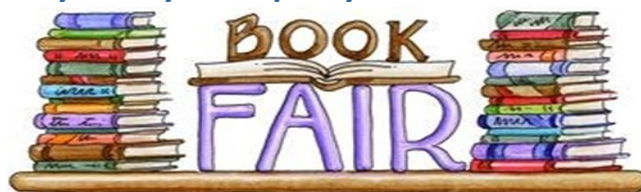
As we enter another seasonal change, please ensure your child has a warm jacket and appropriate shoes.

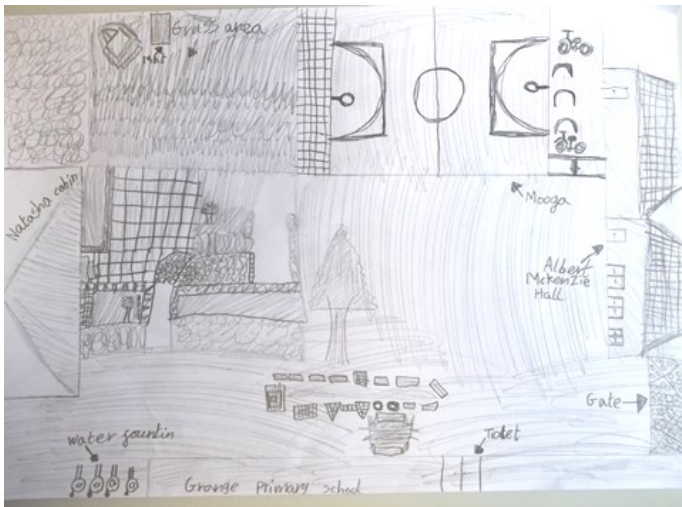
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### Planet Earth

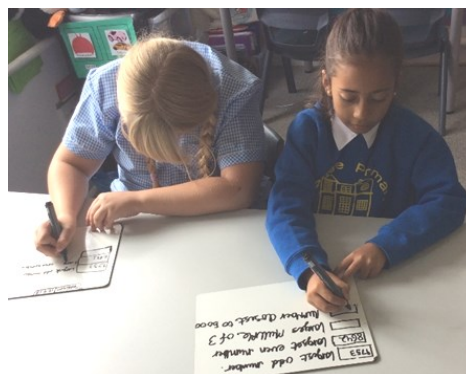

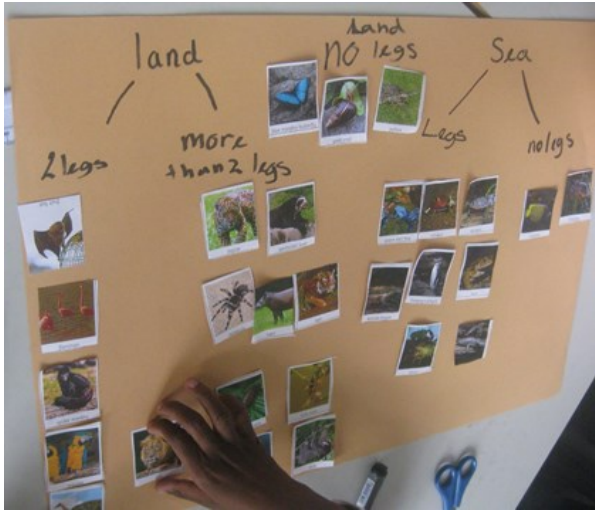
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### Pluto
