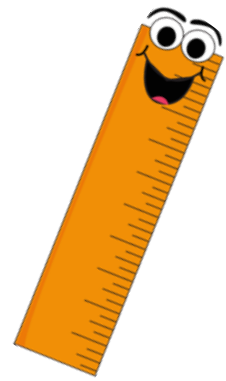


### Neptune
