Mercury

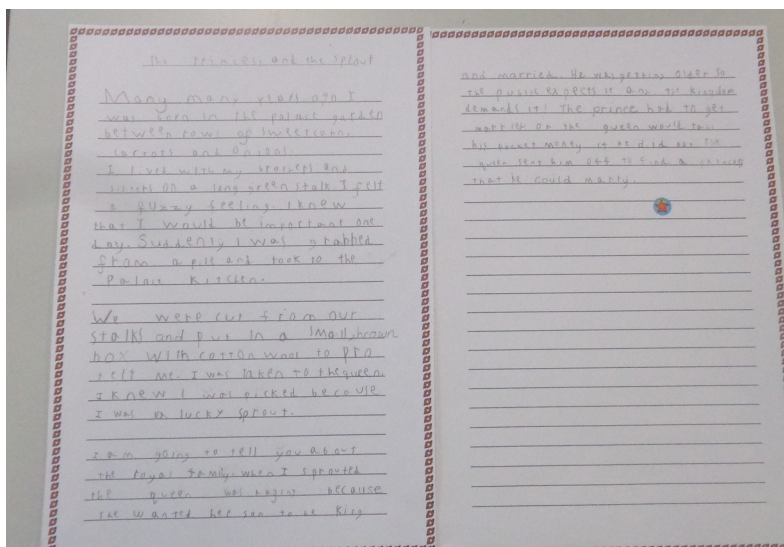

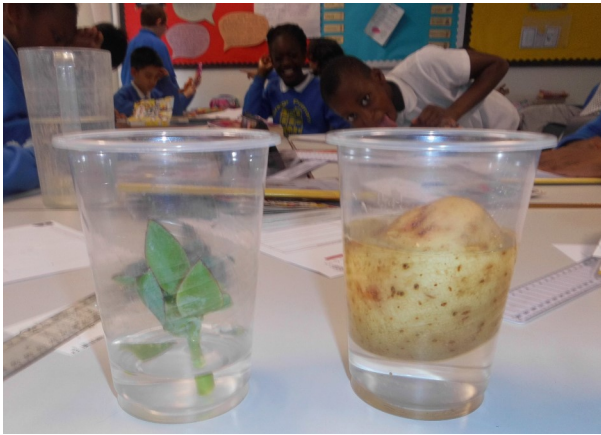

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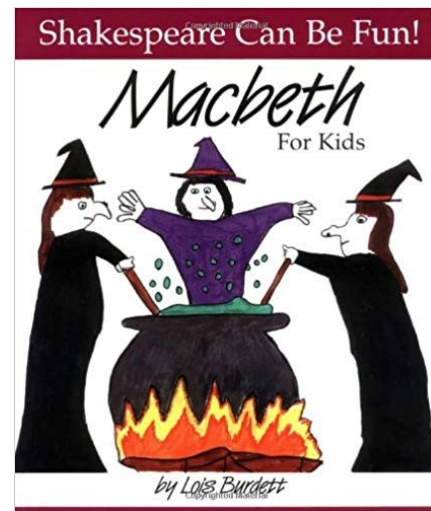


Neptune

As part of our science topic on Living Things and Their Habitats, we have been learning about the different ways that plants reproduce. To investigate how some plants can grow new plants by asexual reproduction, we took a cutting of a succulent plant and put it in a beaker with water. We also put a potato in water! We will watch over the next few weeks to see if the plant cutting and potato will grow roots.

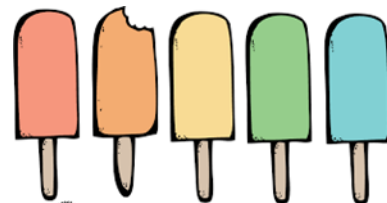
