This week, Neptune Class have been investigating ways of separating materials, including filtering and sieving. In groups, we had to design the best filter to clean a mixture of soil of water, by passing it through a funnel and choosing filter paper or cotton wool to filter out the soil. The aim was to get the cleanest water!
