Dear Grange Families,

May I start by saying a massive thank you for all your support this half- term. Despite the challenges, it has been exceptionally gratifying to see the children settling back in school, with a thirst for knowledge and ready to explore and learn.

I am sure that you look forward to talking about your child with their class teacher. We plan to carry out the parent-teacher meetings in the second week of the next half term. Therefore, all meetings will take place either via Zoom or phone. In the first week of the next half term, we will send you the routine letter for you to choose the day and time to meet your child's class teacher virtually.

As you are aware, London has entered Tier 2 of the government's new system, which means cases of Covid-19 are increasing in London. Please ensure you regularly check the latest government advice to help stop the spread of COVID-19. Some of the main recommendations for Covid -19 alert Level 2 are:

- you must not socialise with anybody outside of your household or support bubble in any indoor setting, whether at home or in a public place
- you must not socialise in a group of more than 6 outside, including in a garden or other spaces like beaches or parks (other than where specific exemptions apply in law)

We are continuing to update our practice in line with new developments to ensure that we can keep everyone as safe as possible. The government's message continues to be that adults are more at risk of spreading the virus than children. With this in mind, we will be kindly asking the adults dropping off or collecting the children to wear a face-covering when queuing at the beginning and end of the day when we return to school on Monday 2 November 2020. The members of staff at entrances will continue to be wearing masks or visors.

With your support and co-operation, we have tightened the start and end of the day timings. Please continue to be prompt. Below is a reminder of the correct time for your child(ren). Please avoid coming too early, or too late.
