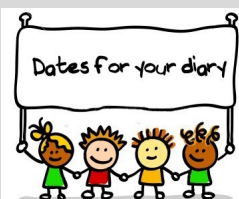

Mercury

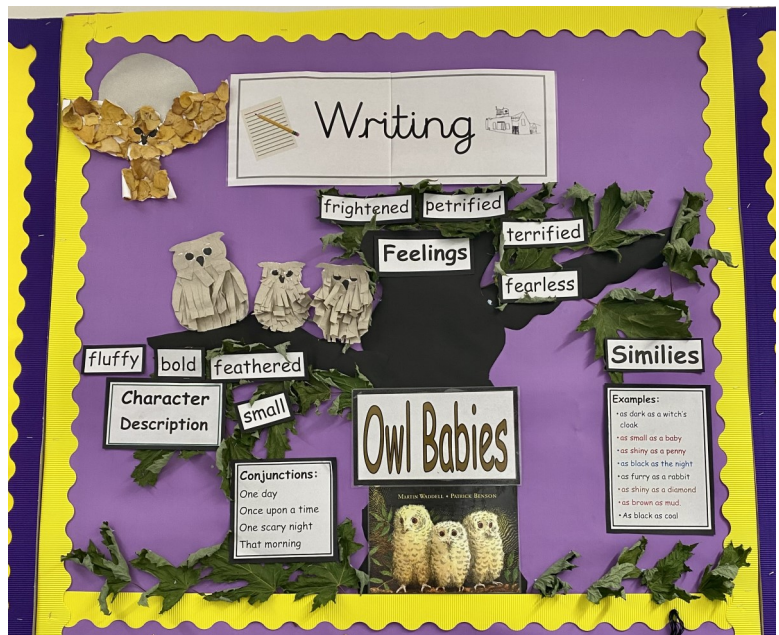

This week in English, Year 2 are reading the book 'Owl Babies'. We have been retelling the story and discussing how the owlets felt at different points in the story.



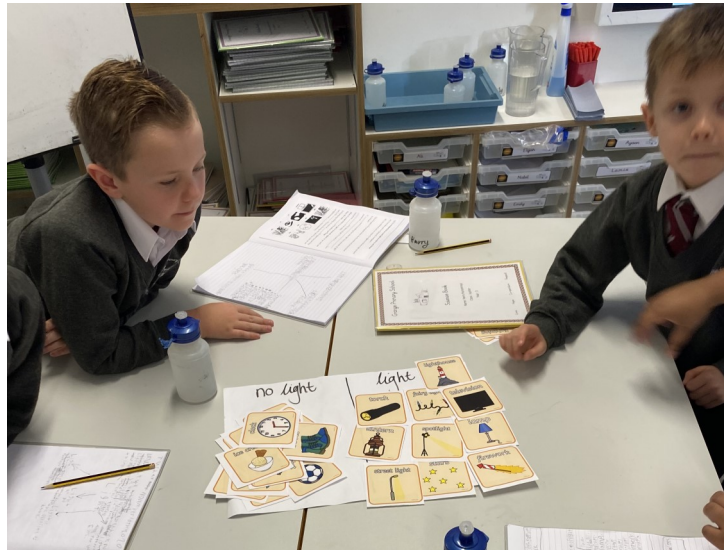
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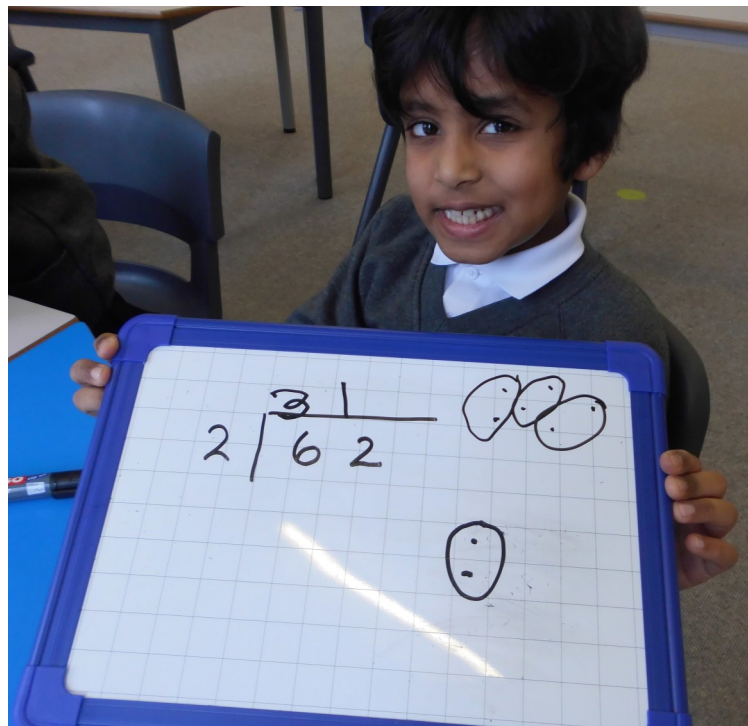
Jupiter
