Dear Grange families,

COVID-19

It has been a very unusual week at Grange Primary School. As you are aware three members of our school community tested positive with COVID-19 this week. We fully appreciate that this will be worrying and difficult for you and your family. However, keeping our children, families, staff and local community safe is our main priority.

We would once again like to assure you that we have followed Public Health England and DfE guidance carefully to manage the situation. As a precautionary measure some members of staff have been requested to self-isolate for 14 days. Some of our pupils were also asked to self-isolate as a precautionary measure as they were deemed to have had close contact with the members of our school community. The school has received an 'enhanced' clean and we continue to follow strict hygiene measures.

Communication

We believe communication with parents is important. However, this is different due to COVID-19 restrictions. We are unable to have conversations at gates or outside classes in the way you have been used to. Please email the school office:

The DfE has clearly stated that parents should not be permitted onto the school site unless it is 'essential'. Parents and visitors attending the school will be expected to wear a face covering unless they are exempt from doing so.

As both the wellbeing and welfare of the children is paramount to us, we ask that you do not use your mobile phones while on the school premises. Grange Primary is a mobile phone free zone!

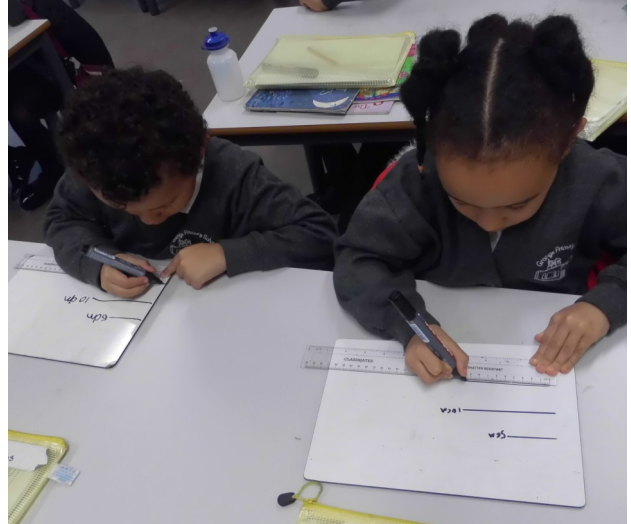

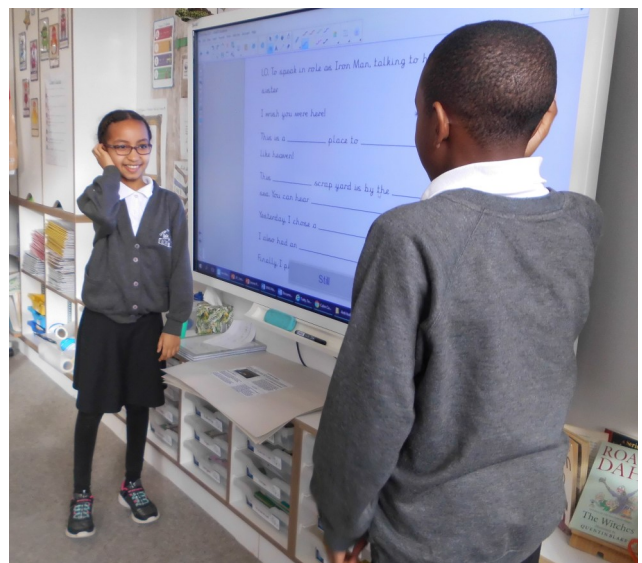


Saturn

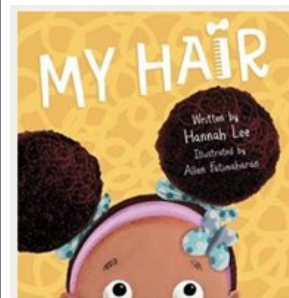

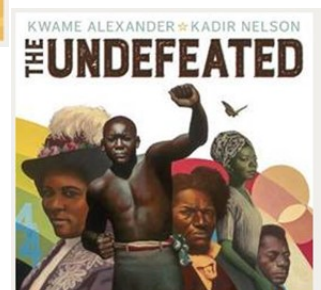
