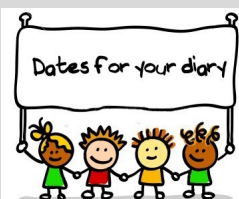

Tier 2– HIGH ALERT

As London moved to Tier 2 local restrictions from 02nd December 2020, we would like to clarify that all children are still expected to attend school unless they are unwell. Keeping young people in education is a national and a school priority. Parents and carers should make sure their children keep attending school during the lockdown. The government has made it clear that schools will continue to remain open despite the additional restrictions. Please remember the **Rule of 6** and avoid gathering in large groups outside of school. You must not socialise with anyone you do not live with or who is not in your support bubble in any indoor setting, whether at home or in a public place, you must not socialise in a group of more than 6 people outside, including in a garden or a public space – this is called the ‘rule of 6’.

Please follow the government’s campaign to reduce the transmission of the virus:

- **Hands** – Wash hands for 20 seconds frequently
- **Face**- Parents coming on to the school premises are requested to wear a face covering, unless you are exempt from wearing one
- **Space**- Please keep a distance from staff and other parents in school and at the gates. Please remember to email questions to office@grange.southwark.sch.uk whenever possible.

Please remind your child/ren of good hygiene standards.

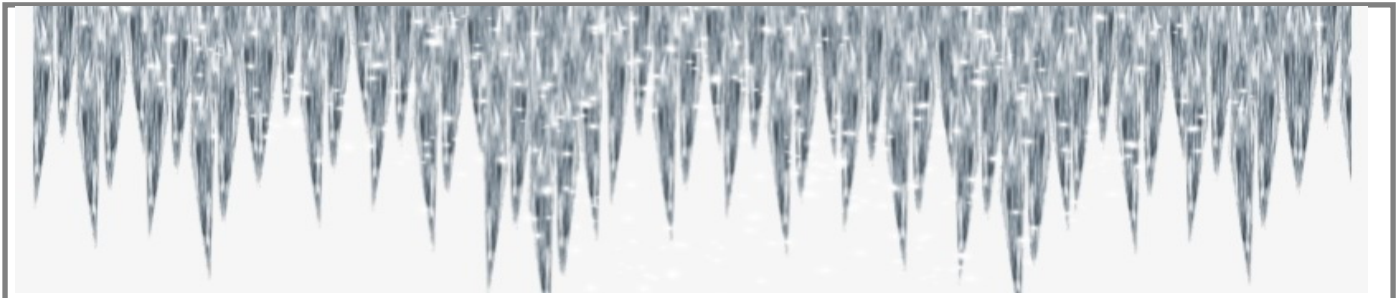

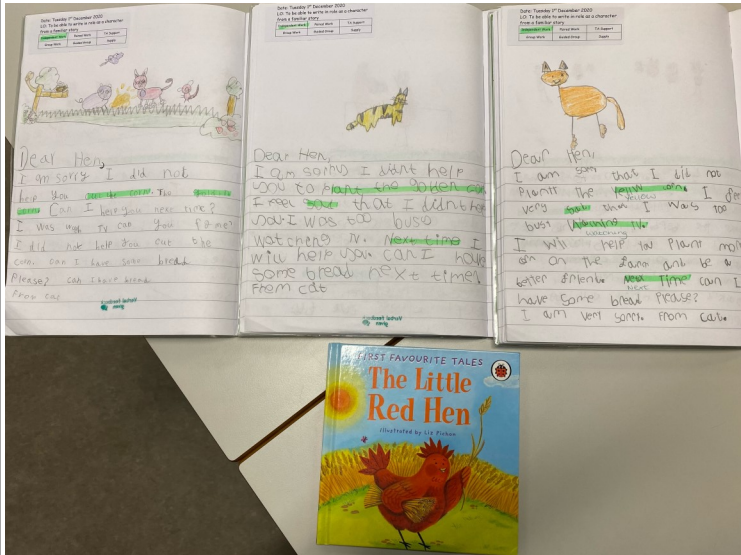

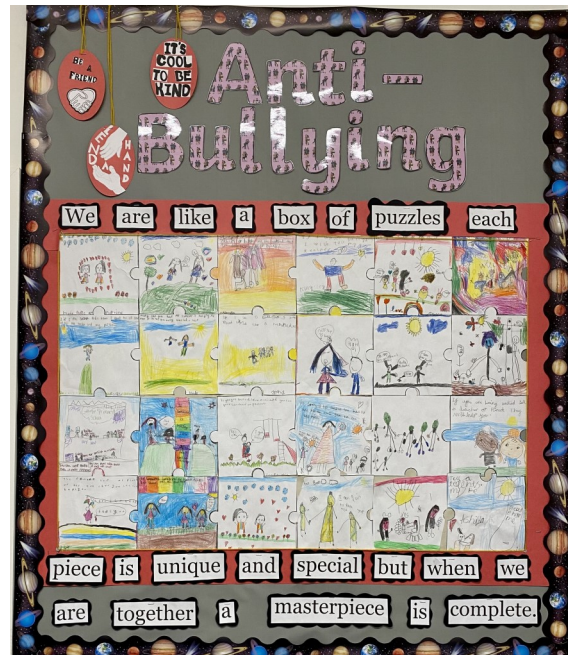
Mercury

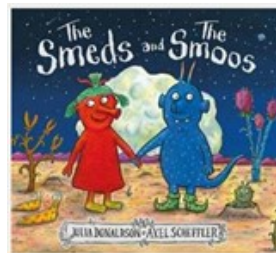

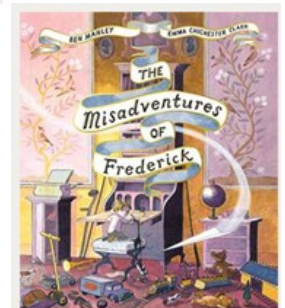
