Dear Grange families,

We hope you are safe and well! We want to thank you for your patience and support with us throughout this difficult start to our Spring term. We would also like to remind you what remote learning arrangements are in place to ensure that children's learning continues, without disruption, throughout this lockdown. We are up and running with our new blended approach of both live and recorded teaching and it all seems to be going relatively smoothly, with the occasional hiccups and some lagging. Thank you for your support as we become more confident using Microsoft Teams. Our staff are working incredibly hard to provide a wide range of well structured, well resourced and interesting lessons for your children. As Interim Headteacher- I am incredibly proud of the staff and the provision they have managed to deliver the children at home in such a short space of time.

However, we do not underestimate how difficult having your children at home is, whilst caring for younger siblings or other family members or having to juggle a full time job. Please try not to be too hard on yourselves - we are after all only human. Remember, if things go pear shaped – your internet fails, or your child has a melt down, that is ok – just let your class teacher know during the 'Meet and Greet' session.

In between lessons – allow for some down time. The BBC have now a dedicated education provision available on CBBC every morning – this may help keep little minds busy, Mr Jaffa Jaffa's 'Wake and Shake' at 09:10am gives our children time to get active as well as see other children in the school virtually. Do not underestimate the power of a quick run around in between lessons – it really helps with concentration.

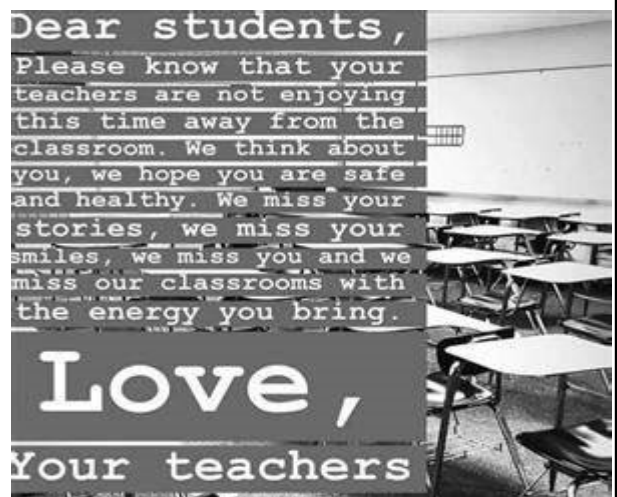
We want to ensure quality and consistency in our approach to remote learning for children who are learning at home. In each parallel year group, one member of staff will be supporting children in school, and the other will be teaching remotely. Staff teaching online will be available throughout the usual school hours to give feedback, and to answer any queries, about the learning.

We recognise that lots of our parents will be working from home, and will need to manage their day as well as their child's, so will require some flexibility around completing tasks, although the expectation will be that children are accessing learning every school day. Lessons will be both live streamed and recorded and uploaded onto Microsoft Teams daily.

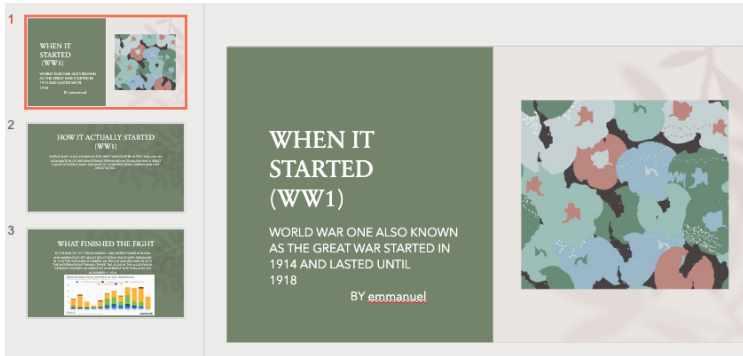
