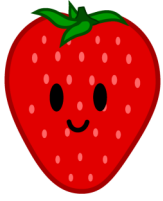

NURSERY

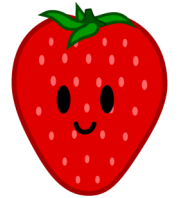


Sun Class
