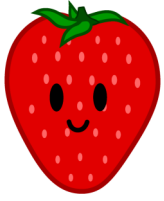

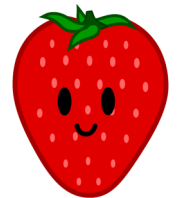
Star & Moon Class
