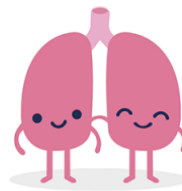

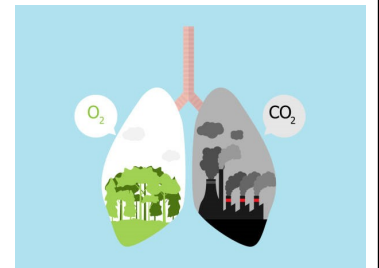
Children’s Health in London & Luton

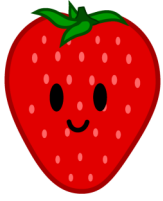

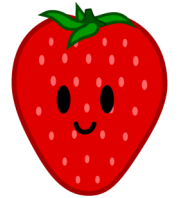


Mercury & Venus Class

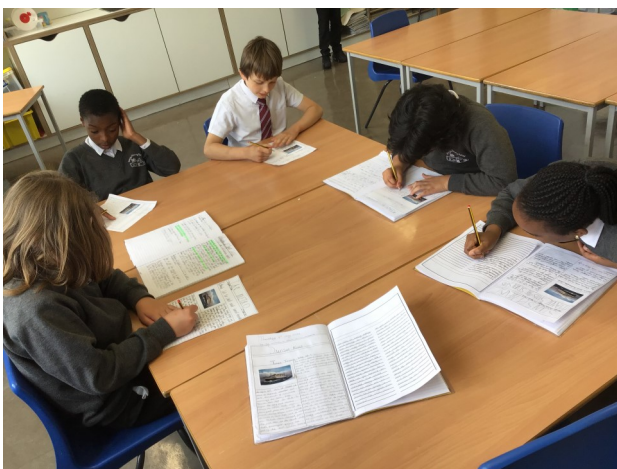


YEAR 5
