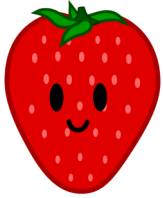

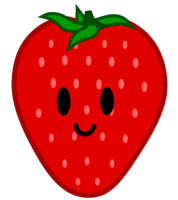
Venus & Mercury Class
