What is Diabetes?

1 in 11 people are living with diabetes right now. Even some of the healthiest people are diabetic. Diabetes is a disease in which the pancreas is no longer able to make insulin (Type 1 Diabetes), or the body cannot live off the insulin that it does create (Type 2 Diabetes). Insulin, the hormone made by the pancreas, helps the glucose in your



blood to be used for energy. Thus, diabetes is a disease in which your blood glucose level (or blood sugar level) is higher than it should be.

Children who are going up to Reception in September are


excited to visit their new Reception this Thursday afternoon.
