They also learned about the dangers and personal risks young people take when joining or being part of a gang. They watched a very powerful film about a former gang member who describes his gang lifestyle and how hard it was for him to leave that lifestyle behind. PC Short left the class with 3 pieces of advice:

- Stay busy doing after school activities;
- don't hang about on the streets
- keep talking to trusted adults about any issues you're having.
