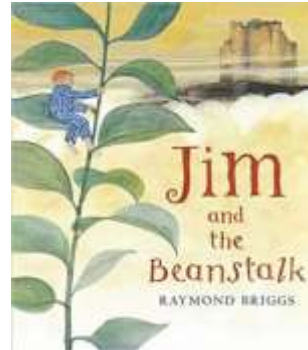
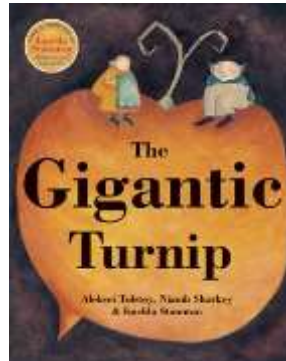


## English: DPiL

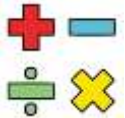
## Maths: Maths mastery
