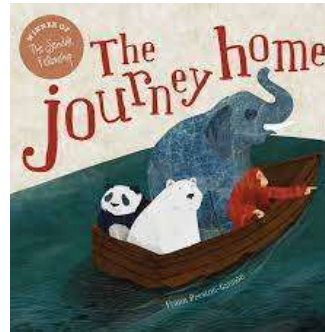


The children will use this text on endangered animals to learn about different sentence types, verb endings, make inferences and write a persuasive letter.

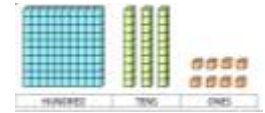
- The Jolly postman

- Skills based approach to reading.



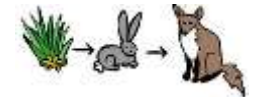
## Topic
