Tadpole's Promise

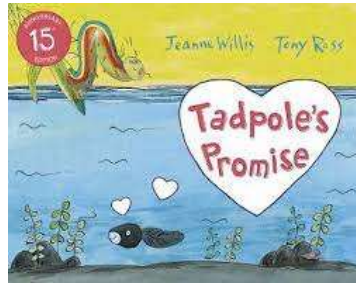
The children will create their own version of the story and write explanations of different life cycles.

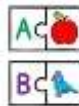
