## Topic

Our new topic will be 'The Seaside' this term. This will be the focus for our history, geography and other foundation subjects. We will be finding out all about the seaside and all the different things there are at the seaside

## English

This term in English, we will begin by focusing on 'Julian is a Mermaid' and then finish the term with 'Sea Saw.' Pupils will write instructions, advertisements, writing in role, letters as well as a poem. They will be taught to apply their phonics knowledge skills when reading and writing. Handwriting will also be an ongoing focus this term.



## Maths

Our first focus of the term will be on counting on partitioning two digit numbers. We will also focus on ordering numbers, money, dates, time to the hour and half an hour as well as writing time.

Please continue to support your child at home by helping them to practice their maths facts and counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. We will continue to set Maths homework on Matheletics.



## Science

Our topic is 'Seasonal changes - Summer' and we will be observing changes that occur across the four seasons and discuss weather in other countries. We will compare tropical climates with colder climates and with the weather in the UK.

## Music

The pupils will have weekly singing assemblies where they will learn a variety of new songs. In addition, pupils will get the opportunity to play different musical instruments in continuous provision as well sing nursery rhymes.



## Art/DT

We will be focusing on portraits and painting landscapes this term in Art.
