MATHS and READING

Weekly tasks are set on Mathletics and Reading Eggs. Please make sure you log in to complete tasks set. Certificates will be awarded during celebration assembly. If you are experiencing any problems on Mathletics or Reading Eggs please do let us know ASAP, so we can sort this for you.

Maths: Topics we will be working on in Maths in Years 1 and 2 include length and height, and measurement and capacity. Please practice measuring using a ruler with your child. Why not have a go at measuring using grams for a recipe or measuring the amount of liquid in ml needed to make jelly/custard/gravy etc?

Reading: Please also remember to read for at least 10 minutes each day and get an adult to sign your reading record book.



You have this scrap book to use to complete your homework project. Over the next six weeks complete some of these activities or make some up of your own.

Reading and Writing

Year 1 will be using Astro Girl to support their writing sessions. They will be learning how to write simple then compound sentences with adjectives and conjunctions.

Year 2 will be using the texts 'The Bear and the piano' and 'A big book of bears'. They will be learning about different sentence types, expanded noun phrases and punctuation marks.

Year 1's next science unit is Seasons. Can they create a weather log or collage to show how the seasons change?

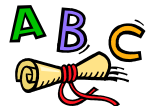


Year 2's next Science unit is Light and dark. Can they find, draw and record different light sources? Can they identify what is natural and artificial light?
