MATHS

Weekly tasks are set on Mathletics. Please make sure you log in to complete the tasks set. Certificates will be given during Friday's celebration assembly. Our focus this half term is Place Value and recognising numbers, with aim of being able to write them in numerals and words. Practise this at home as well as counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and 3s.



READING

Reading Eggs is a platform similar to Mathletics. It supports children with reading and phonics. We will set the children tasks on a weekly basis.

Your child will be sent home with a decodable reader pitched at their phonics level and a 'sharing' story book of their choice. The reader is for them to show you how clear they are at their reading, and the story book is for you to share and enjoy together. Children may recognise some high frequency words in there, so encourage them to pick them out. Children should be reading for at least 10 minutes each day and an adult will need to sign the reading record. We will change books weekly, if your child is confident in what they are reading and are able to answer questions about what they have just read.



WRITING AND TOPIC

You have this scrap book to use to complete your homework project. Over the next six weeks complete some of these activities or make some up of your own.

WRITING TASKS

- Research and write an interesting fact about each continent.
- Research the countries in the United Kingdom and create a Fact File on what they are famous for.

CHALLENGE!

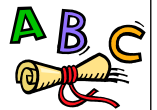
- Why don't you try creating a poster about a country that is special to you. Try to include what continent it is on, the surrounding seas, flag, famous food, the language/s spoken there, national flowers, animals, physical features and any other interesting facts you find out... or create a 3D model of a landmark from one of these countries.
- In science we are learning about animals including humans and life cycles. Can you create a drawing of the lifecycle of your favourite animal.

PLACES YOU COULD VISIT

In English we are reading and retelling A Walk in London. Why don't you visit the famous landmarks including Big Ben, the Shard, the Tower of London or the London eye?

SPELLINGS

We have attached the spelling list for year 2. Please use this list to support your child in learning their spellings. We will check they are spelling them correctly in their work. In Year 2 we also need to learn how to write numbers to 100. Why don't you have a go.



PHONICS

We follow Little Wandle Letters and Sounds Revised phonics programme. In Year 2 we will recap all sounds from Year 1 and then move into spelling patterns for KS1, to help us with our reading and spelling.
