Topic (History/ Geography)

Our new topic will be 'Britain and Beyond'. We will be exploring the UK, focusing on its geographical features including mountains and rivers, and comparing these to other countries within Europe.

English

This term in English, we will begin by focusing on 'Beowulf' by Michael Morpurgo. We will be using this book to help develop children's writing skills within the context of fiction texts, myths and poetry. We will look at different text features and develop our writing skills across a range of genres. In addition, we will explore the magical world of 'The Firework Maker's Daughter' by Phillip Pullman to develop our reading skills. In guided reading lessons, we will support children in their developing literacy. Each week, we will also do comprehension, reading and spelling activities and continued handwriting practice to encourage pride in presentation.

Maths

Our first focus of the year will be on number and place value. This will include recapping and developing children's partitioning and calculation skills, leading onto addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Please continue to support your child at home by helping them to practice their maths facts and times tables!

<u>Science</u>

Our first topic is **Changes in Materials.** We will be looking at the properties of everyday materials, the relationship between different substances and demonstrate that dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible changes. We will give reasons, based on evidence from comparative and fair tests, for the particular uses of everyday materials,

<u>Music</u>

This year, the children will be having the wonderful experience of learning the ukulele. A letter detailing this further will be sent at a later date.

Art/DT

In our art lessons we will be creating 'Who Am I?' portraits and will look at famous artists including Tracey Emin and Lucian Freud.

<u>PE</u>

Our lessons will take place on Tuesday and Thursday. Please make sure PE kits are worn on these days. Our first PE focus will be team games and our inside PE lessons will focus on games.

<u>PSHE</u>

In PSHE, we will be looking at targets for the year, how to be a good citizen and identify how we are responsible in the world
