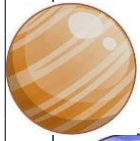

## MATHS

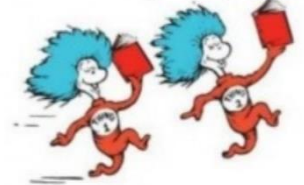

Other activities:

1. Draw or paint a landscape in the UK e.g. the Peak District
2. Make a model of a coast line or small village
3. Research 3 countries and compare them to the UK
4. Plan and budget an imaginary holiday to somewhere in Europe!

  - plan for flights/transport, accommodation, food, activities
