Topic (Geography)

Our new topic will be Britain Today – How can I be a global citizen? This will be our geography and foundation focus for the term. We will be exploring how the United Kingdom trades with other countries. We will also be looking at how land is used locally and throughout the UK.

English

This term in English, we will begin by focusing on the story 'The Three Little Pigs' with a twist. We will be investigating whether the Wolf was actually guilty of murder or whether he was framed by one of the 3 pigs. Throughout this topic, we will write reports, balanced discussions and persuasive texts.

Maths

Our first focus of the year will be on number and place value. This will include recapping and developing children's partitioning and calculation skills, leading onto addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.
