Venus Class

Topic

The children will be focusing on the Topic 'Life then, Compared to Now.' In Year 1 the children will be learning to compare life from the past to life now; from The Victorian era through the, 50s, 60s, 70's, 80's and until now. This will include researching and learning about how schools were in the past, comparing what houses were like and looked like inside, the toys the children had and the type of toys they have now alongside the different types of transport from the past and how these changes have impacted our life today.

English (reading and writing)

In English the children will be focusing on the texts 'The Naughty Bus' by Jan Oke and 'Billy and The Beast' by Nadia Shireen. The children will be developing their vocabulary through describing different scenes in the text, asking key questions; drama and retelling the main events of a story. Year 1 will focus on skills such as using their phonics to write words; orally rehearsing sentences and using full stops and capital letters correctly within simple sentences.

During reading sessions, the children will read 1:1 or in a group either with Miss Lisa, Miss Jo Miss Ellie or Miss Stephanie. This will ensure that each child will be able to further develop their phonic knowledge and comprehension skills. These reading sessions will be logged into their reading records. Whilst 1:1 reads are taking place, other children will be completing reading activities including, reading for pleasure. These sessions may take place in the classroom, or in the library so that the children are exposed to different texts and reading environments. Please ensure your child brings their reading record and their reading book to school every day!

Maths

Our focus in Year 1 for this half term is addition and subtraction moving into shape towards the end of the term. Children will be learning how to partition numbers using the part-part whole model and fact families. In shape, the children will be looking at and naming 2D and 3D shapes, looking at their properties and sorting them. Please keep accessing Mathletics for daily and weekly activities.

Science

In science this half term, we will be looking at 'Everyday Materials'. The children will become 'mini scientists' using every day materials to compare what material works best in our investigations. They will learn some of these experiments through rhymes and stories such as 'Humpty Dumpty' and 'The Three Little Pigs'.

<u>Music</u>

The children have begun weekly Music lessons with a specialist teacher from Southwark Music services. Venus class are learning how to use their voices expressively and creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes.

Art/DT

In Art and D.T, we will be focusing on Pop art using a range of colour and shape; this will be completed by using paint and dye.

<u>P.E.</u>

The children will receive two P.E. sessions a week – once with a specialist P.E. coach from the London P.E. network and once with their class teacher. Please make sure PE kits are brought into to school on Monday. Children will be expected to wear their school uniform to school and change before the lesson. Our first PE focus this half term will be gymnastics. P.E. will take place on the following days: **Tuesday and Thursdays.**

RF

The children will be focusing on 'How do Christians celebrate Christmas?'. This will be taught on a weekly basis.

The children will be learning simple greetings, numbers and colours through songs.
