MATHS

Weekly tasks are set on Mathletics. Please make sure you log in to complete the tasks set. Certificates will be given during Friday's celebration assembly. Our focus this half term is addition and subtraction of numbers within 100. We will also be starting our multiplication topic this half term too.



READING

Reading Eggs is a platform similar to Mathletics. It supports children with reading and phonics. We will set the children tasks on a weekly basis.

PLACES YOU COULD VISIT

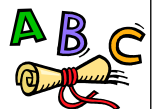
Why not talk a walk down pudding lane? See if you can spot the old Tudor house, which is similar to the houses built in 1666.
