
DATE DUE: Friday 15th December Dear children and adults,

READING:

Remember to read each day and get an adult to **sign** your reading record. Try to discuss the book with an adult or sibling and discuss the text/ answer questions about it.

WRITING AND TOPIC

This will be learning all about the UK during the Victorian era from 1837-1901. This term, complete some of these activities or make up your own!

Try to complete at least one of these topic writing tasks:

- 1. Write a biography about Queen Victoria and her reign. Why was she influential? What achievements did the UK have in that time period?
- 2. Write a non-chronological report about significant inventions during the Victorian era. Some examples: the Railway network, the telephone, the Penny-Farthing bicycle, electric bulbs and the tube network.
- 3. Research some of these key terms and find out more about them: migration, industry, revolution, typhoid, arithmetic, livestock, rural.

Other activities related to our English texts:

- 1. Watch the film 'Hidden Figures' with an adult or with adult permission. Can you write down what you learnt from the film?
- 2. Do some brainstorming about our Guided reading text, The Polar Bear Explorer's Club. Write a narrative at home about the adventures of an explorer, using our narrative toolkit!

Other activities related to our English texts

- Narrative Toolkit

 Use a 5-part story structure
- Use third person
- Use past tense
- Use a range of descriptive devices to develop characters, settings and atmosphere (ENP, vivid verbs)
- Use varied sentence length to build tension (fronted adverbials, conjunctions)
- Use accurate punctuation to demarcate sentences
