Home learning scrapbook ideas - Autumn 2



Communication and Language :

In class we are working a lot on speaking in full sentences. Play games and chat to us, helping us to speak without missing out words. Maybe help us to cook porridge and see if we can follow or give instructions, like we will practice at school.

Local area trips and visits :

Visit the park— can you see the differences as the seasons change? Maybe you can collect some conkers or sticks to bring into school.

Visit a local library to read a book quietly. What books did you like the best and why? Did you spot any of the traditional tales that we have been learning in school?

Our topic this half term is...



Traditional tales

English

Keep reading the home reader at least 3 times a week, and remember to write in the reading diary!

Practice name writing. Remembering the capital letter at the beginning, but small letters for the rest.

In the scrapbook, draw some of your favourite traditional tale characters and label them if you can! (Goldilocks, Little Red Riding Hood, The Three Little Pigs)

Ask us to show you the stories we are learning at school using the words and the actions!

Understanding the World

Go outside and see how the seasons change from autumn to winter. Can you spot autumn leaves? Do you see the leaves fall off of trees? Can you feel the temperature change? Take pictures and write your child's comments in their book.

Talk about special days celebrated by your family.

Physical Development :

This term we will be starting PE! We will need our own PE kits, and will be getting dressed and undressed on our own. Please encourage us and give us opportunities to do this independently at home.

We will also be practicing jumping! Please play jumping games with us!

Personal, Social, Emotional

This term we will be learning about what makes us special. Help us to think of our special things we are good at! Ask us to tell you what we think you're good at! We will be sharing kind thoughts about our friends at school.

Expressive Art and Design

This term we will be making diya lamps, firework pictures and autumn and winter art! We will be using natural materials to collage and explore. See if we can make a picture in the park using twigs or conkers. Give us lots of opportunities to colour, draw and cut when at home to help our fine motor skills!

Mathematics : Have a go at:

1. Comparing things around the house and outside. What is taller or shorter? How do we know? What is longer or shorter? How do we know? Can we make long and short lines with our toys or snakes with playdough?
2. Have a go at making patterns. Use toys, colours and natural resources. Take a picture to put in our book.
3. Counting up to 5 accurately, moving one object at a time as we count. Counting the correct number of things, not going past the stop number.
