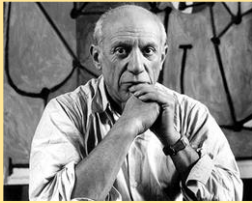

Line	a long, narrow mark or band.
Vertical	an upright line
Horizontal	parallel to the plane of the horizon
3D	three-dimensional.
2D	Two-dimensional
Detail	an individual fact or item
Sculpture	the art of making three-dimensional representative or abstract forms.
Wavy	having a form or edge that smoothly curves in and out
Smooth	having an even and regular surface
Portrait	a painting, drawing, photograph, or engraving of a person
Cut	make an opening, incision, or wound in (something) with a sharp-edged tool or object
