Vocabulary

Mix 	combine or put together to form one substance or mass.
Knead 	work (moistened flour or clay) into dough or paste with the hands.
Stir 	move a spoon or other implement round in (a liquid or other substance) in order to mix it thoroughly.
Whisk 	take or move (someone or something) somewhere suddenly and quickly.
Bowl 	a round, deep dish or basin used for food or liquid.
Spoon 	an implement consisting of a small, shallow oval or round bowl on a long handle, used for eating, stirring, and serving food.
Flour 	a powder obtained by grinding grain, typically wheat, and used to make bread, cakes, and pastry.
