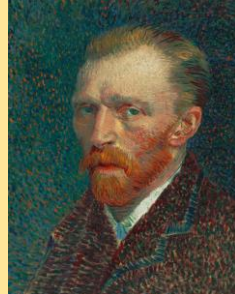
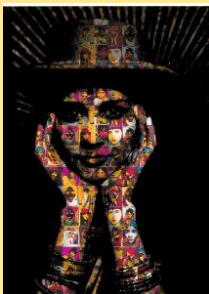

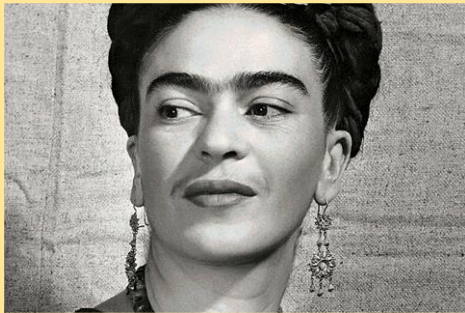


Vocabulary

Background	the part of a picture, scene, or design that forms a setting for the main figures or objects, or appears furthest from the viewer.
Collage	a piece of art made by sticking various different materials such as photographs and pieces of paper or fabric on to a backing.
Portrait	a painting, drawing, photograph, or engraving of a person, especially one depicting only the face or head and shoulders.
Texture	the feel, appearance, or consistency of a surface or substance.
Evaluate	form an idea of the amount, number, or value of; assess.
Justify	how or prove to be right or reasonable.
Mixed Media	variety of media used in an entertainment or work of art.
Multi Media	using more than one medium of expression or communication.
Atmosphere	the envelope of gases surrounding the earth or another planet.
Composition	the nature of something's ingredients or constituents; the way in which a whole or mixture is made up.
Photomontage	the process and the result of making a composite photograph by cutting, gluing, rearranging and overlapping two or more photographs into a new image

Who is David Hockney?

David Hockney (born 9 July 1937) is an English painter, draftsman, printmaker, stage designer, and photographer. As an important contributor to the pop art movement of the 1960s, he is considered one of the most influential British artists of the 20th century.
