How to make a wax resist watercolour painting inspired by Henry Moore

Vocabulary

silhouettes	the dark shape and outline of someone or something visible in restricted light against a brighter background
chiaroscuro	the treatment of light and shade in drawing and painting
sculptor	an artist who makes sculptures
draughtsman	a person who makes detailed technical plans or drawings
construct	build or make (something, typically a building, road, or machine)
designing	to make or draw plans for something, for example clothes or buildings
bending	shape or force (something straight) into a curve or angle.
twisting	form into a bent, curling , or distorted shape
reinforcing	strengthen or support (an object or substance), especially with additional material
stable	An object or structure not likely to give way or overturn ; firmly fixed
