

5 words to remember

audio: sound, such as spoken narration

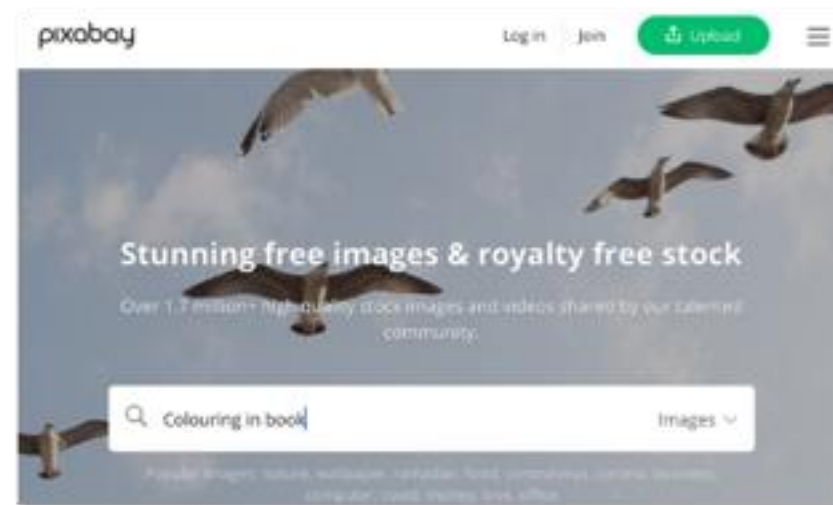
Creative Commons: helps people share with others their special creations, like drawings or stories, so everyone can enjoy them


eBook: a book that lives inside a computer or tablet – it's not made of paper, but it's full of exciting stories and pictures that we can read and explore!

image: a picture, such as a drawing or photograph

narration: a commentary, description or explanation of what happens in a video

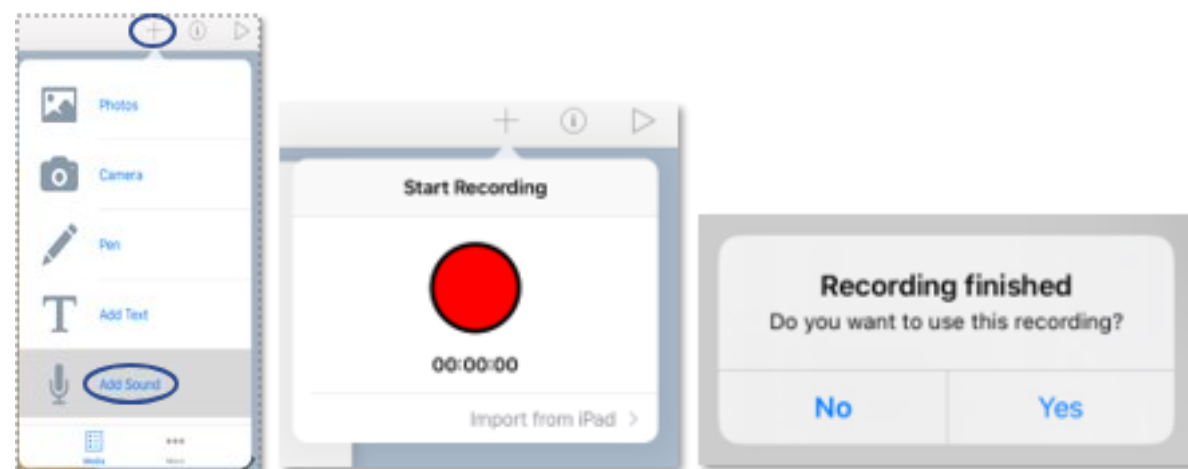

Knowledge check: Adding audio narration

Step 1: To add **narration**, first open the Book Creator app on your iPad, then click the '+' at the top of the screen.

Step 2: Then click 'add sound'. A red button will appear that says 'Start Recording'.

Step 3: Now add your **audio**. When you've finished, click the red button and then choose to add the recording, or not to add it.



Knowledge check: Adding images

We can add images to Book Creator:

Step 1: First, open the app on your iPad. Then click the '+' at the top of the screen.

Step 2: Look for a button that looks like a picture. When you find it, tap on it!

Step 3: Pick the picture you want to add to your book by tapping on it.
