

## 5 words to remember

**camera roll:** an app on iPads where all images are stored

**colour value:** the mixture of red, green and blue values, which make up **pixels** on a screen

**edit:** change or correct a piece of work after the first go

**filter:** change all the pixels in an image, such as 'dramatic' or 'silvertone'

**pixel:** picture element – one of the small, square dots that makes up a digital image

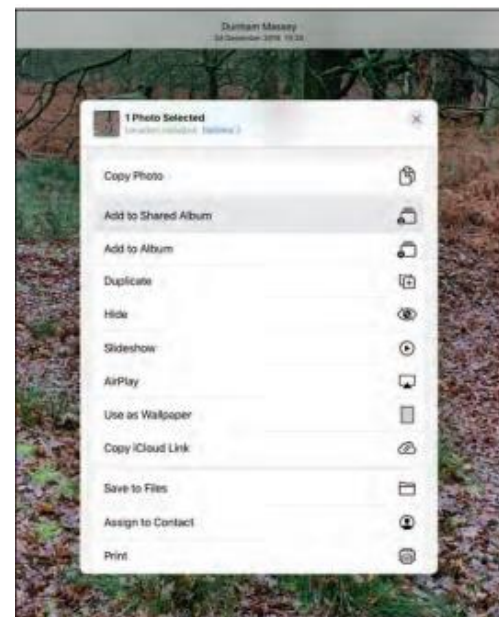
