MATHS and READING

Mathletics

Weekly tasks are set on Mathletics and Reading Eggs. Please make sure you log in to complete tasks set. Certificates will be awarded once they are printed. If you are experiencing any problems on Mathletics or Reading Eggs please do let us know ASAP, so we can sort this for you.; I know there have been a few issues last half term.

Maths: Topics we will be working on in Maths include length and height, and measurement and capacity. Please practice measuring using a ruler with your child and also with informal units eg. Pieces of lego the same size, buttons, hands, feet etc. Children could also have a go at measuring using grams for a recipe or measuring the amount of liquid in ml needed to make jelly/custard/gravy etc.

Reading: Please also remember to read for at least 10 minutes each day and get an adult to sign your reading record book.



You have this scrap book to use to complete your homework project. Over the next few weeks complete some of these activities or make some up of your own.

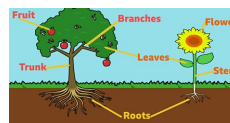
Reading and Writing

Year 1 will be reading Astro Girl and Emma Jane's Aeroplane to support their writing sessions. They will be learning how to write simple and compound sentences with different type of word classes such as; verbs, conjunctions, adverbs and adjectives. **Why don't you research on a famous women who flew aeroplanes or female astronauts who went into space!?**

Science and Art

Our next science unit is Plants. Can children have a go at one or more of the following?

Drawing and labelling the different parts of a flower or tree.



Tasting different types of vegetables (carrots, radishes, lettuces, cucumber etc.) Which do they like/dislike? Take some pictures send them to us and we can upload these to Instagram. Write some sentences on why you like/dislike it.

Growing a small plant, cress seeds or a bean. What does the plant need? Can you take or draw pictures of the process? Can you write instructions on what you did to support the growth of the plant? Write a diary on the process of your cress/ plant growing?

Please keep practising blending sounds at home using alternative sounds when you need to. Parents, if you need help, please ask me at the end of the school day :).

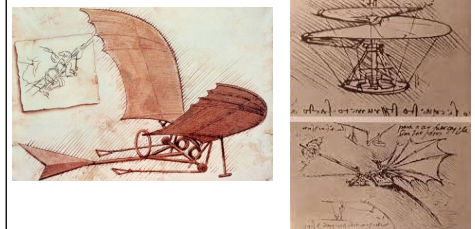
Spelling and Phonics
