Topic

Our topic this half term will be 'Stone Age'. This will be the focus for our History and other foundation subjects. We will be finding out about Stone Age way of life and doing some exciting Art/DT work as well.



English

This term in English, we will begin by focusing on 'Our First drawing' which links with our topic. Pupils will write character descriptions, diary entries and much more! They will be taught to apply their phonics knowledge skills when reading and writing. Handwriting will also be an ongoing focus this term.

Maths

This term will be recapping on place value, addition and subtraction. Then our focus will be on fractions, money and time. This will involve finding unit fractions and non-unit fractions as well some practical lessons for using money and telling the time.

Science

Our topic this term is 'Plants.' Pupils will learn about the different parts of the plants and their functions. They will also carry out investigations to find out what the best conditions are for plants to grow.
