Topic (history)

Our new topic will be "Power to the people". This will be our history focus for the term. We will be learning about the roles and rights of women and how this has changed over time.



English

Initially in English, we will continue focusing on The Water Tower. We will be writing a newspaper article based on this text. Then we'll move onto 'The Arrival' where we will be writing a diary entry, first person recounts and a 3rd person narrative.



Maths

In Mathematics, we will be revising a number of topics to prepare the children for SATs (long multiplication, worded problems, fractions, percentages, statistics, BODMAS and long division). We are aiming for every child to reach at least 'Rock Legend' status. We will be setting weekly Mathletics homework which will be checked every Friday.

Science

This term, our topic during Science will be 'balanced forces'. We will be learning about forces that affect our daily lives. We will investigate the impact gravity has and we will also run investigations to observe the effect of friction.

This term in music, we will be working through 'Music Express' lessons to gradually build to a class performance.
