Behaviour Expectations

Participation on our school trips depends on students' behaviour. To promote positive conduct and manage misbehaviour, we've implemented a trip-attendance behaviour system. Each child starts with **20 points** at the end of their SATs. Points are deducted for inappropriate behaviour based on the severity of the action:

- **An "Internal" incident results in a 5-point deduction.**
- **"Red Card" leads to a 4-point deduction.**
- **A "Minus 10" indicates a severe offense and 3-point deduction.**
- **"Minus 5" equates to a 2-point deduction.**
- **"Warning 2" equates to a 1-point deduction.**

If a student reaches zero points, they will not be allowed to attend the trip. The points reset for each new trip, giving children the opportunity to demonstrate positive behaviour and earn their place on future trips. This system encourages students to make good choices and creates a safer, more enjoyable experience for everyone. If a child cannot attend a trip, for behaviour related reasons, then a full refund will be provided.
