We have teamed up with residential specialists PGL for the Year 6 end of year visit. We will be travelling to Surrey to their centre at Marchants Hill for a three-day visit from **Monday 8th July to Wednesday 10th July 2024**. Please note that more detailed information will be provided in addition to this letter.

Travel Timings

- Pick up from Grange Primary School: 10:30 am.
- **Arrive** at PGL Centre 12 noon (approximately)
- **Return** Wednesday 10th July. Return to Grange Primary at 3.00-3.30pm (approximately).

Unfortunately, parents & guardians won't be able to come onto the school's grounds on the day the children depart, however, we welcome you to wait outside the school to wave your children goodbye.

Packing Guide

Please note that what you pack for your child will have to be repacked before their return journey. Please don't overpack.

What to Pack?

- **Sleeping bag and pillowcase (preferred)**
OR- duvet cover and pillowcase
- Suitable nightwear x2
- Underwear (extra is advisable)
- Socks (that cover ankles for many activities)
- Trousers/leggings for activities (not jeans)
- Shorts
- 1 pair of trainers for activities
- 1 pair of waterproof shoes (old trainers are ideal)
- Reusable plastic drinks bottle
- Sun cream
- 1 pair of dry shoes for evening activities
- Fleece/sweatshirts
- Long sleeved shirt/t-shirt (for activities where arms need to be covered)
- T-shirts
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if you have them)
- Baseball hat/sun hat
- 1 or 2 sets of clothes for the evening
- Small rucksack/bag
- Labelled bin bag for wet and dirty clothing
- Wash bag with flannel, soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste
- Hair bands for long hair

FAQ

Can my child bring their mobile phone?
