MATHS and READING

Weekly tasks are set on Mathletics and Reading Eggs, please make sure you log in to complete tasks set. If you are experiencing any technical difficulties on Mathletics and Reading Eggs please do let us know. We have sent login's home in their reading record or scrap book.

Maths: We are focusing on shape and place value within 20



Reading: Please also remember to read for at least 10 minutes each day and get an adult to sign your reading record. We will change books weekly. Your child should be confident in what they are reading and are able to answer questions about what they have just read. Encourage your child to spot the tricky words in their text and retell the story in their own words.

Topic and writing

Our topic this half term is 'How does life now compare to the past?' Could you ask members of your family about toys they played with or what their home looked like and write about it.
